

Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics







Figure 3. On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage

Figure 4. On–Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage






Figure 5. On–Resistance Variation with Temperature




Figure 7. Gate-to-Source and Drain-to-Source Voltage vs. Total Charge




Figure 8. Resistive Switching Time Variation vs. Gate Resistance




Figure 9. Diode Forward Voltage vs. Current




Figure 10. Maximum Rated Forward Biased Safe Operating Area




Figure 11. Maximum Avalanche Energy vs. Starting Junction Temperature




Figure 12. G<sub>FS</sub> vs. I<sub>D</sub>




Figure 13. Avalanche Characteristics





Figure 14. Thermal Response


